**ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS TO REDACT PERSONAL IDENTIFIERS
EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2014**

At its September 2014 session, the Judicial Conference approved several changes to the appellate, district, and bankruptcy court miscellaneous fee schedules. As a result, the Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma requires the following procedure to comply with the new fee. The fee and procedure will become effective **December 1, 2014**.

Motion to Redact Personal Identifiers in documents shall be accomplished by filing a motion, submitting a proposed order and paying the prescribed fee. The filer may redact multiple documents in a single case within one motion. The fee is applicable to both open and closed cases. The motion shall be served on the Debtor and any individual whose personal identifiers have been exposed, the Trustee and the U.S. Trustee. A certificate of service shall be filed at the time of filing the motion. The court will not require a Motion to Reopen a case solely to address a Motion to Redact Personal Identifiers from a document. After the Order is entered granting said relief, the movant shall refile the document with the personal identifiers redacted within seven (7) days of the entry of the Order.


If a Debtor desires to file a Motion to Redact Personal Identifiers from a document that was filed by a party other than the Debtor, the Debtor may file a Motion and proposed order to request that the prescribed fee be waived. After the Order is entered granting the Motion to Redact Personal Identifiers, the filer of the original document shall refile the document with the personal identifiers redacted within seven (7) days of the entry of the Order.

If a party is required to file a Motion to Redact Personal Identifiers in multiple affected cases, the party should open a Miscellaneous Proceeding and pay the prescribed fee for a Miscellaneous Proceeding to address the motion and any related responses. The omnibus motion should identify the affected cases and information to be redacted in each case. The Miscellaneous Proceeding shall be served on the Debtor and any individual whose personal identifiers have been exposed, the Trustee and the U.S. Trustee. A certificate of service shall be filed at the time of filing the motion. The court will not require a Motion to Reopen cases for the purpose of filing a Miscellaneous Proceeding solely to address a Motion to Redact Personal Identifiers. After the Order is entered granting said relief, the movant shall refile the document(s) with the personal identifiers redacted

within seven (7) days of the entry of the Order. This General Order supersedes General Order 13-01.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
