**ORDER SETTING PRESUMPTIVE FEE FOR DEBTOR'S COUNSEL IN
CHAPTER 13 BANKRUPTCY CASES**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective January 1, 2017, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma will allow \$4,750 as a reasonable, presumptive fee for attorneys representing debtors in a basic bankruptcy case filed under Chapter 13 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. The presumptive fee covers routine legal services from preparation and filing of a chapter 13 case through confirmation and shall include one post-confirmation modification. Attorneys charging the presumptive fee are not required to file a fee application. Attorneys should charge less than this amount if circumstances warrant.
