GENERAL ORDER NO. 18-08

ORDER

The Court finds it necessary to revise Local Rule 1001-1(H)(17), 5001-2(A) and (B) and 9011-3(A) and (D)(2) as a result of the Court's recent relocation and to reflect the December 1, 2018, amendments to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 5005.

Therefore, the following rules are revised as set forth:

RULE 1001-1. SCOPE OF RULES AND FORMS; DEFINITIONS

H. Definitions.

17. **Electronic Signature.** The typed name constitutes the signature of said party or attorney on any electronically filed pleading or other document. See also Local Rule 9011-1.

RULE 5001-2. CLERK - OFFICE LOCATION/HOURS

A. Location of the Court. The Bankruptcy Court is located in the U.S. Post Office and Courthouse Building at 101 N. 5th Street Muskogee, Oklahoma, 74401. This is the address that should be used for all deliveries.

RULE 9011-3. SIGNATURES


A. Every pleading or other document electronically filed shall contain a signature. In the signature block on all Court papers signed electronically or conventionally, the attorney must be identified by name, state bar number, complete mailing address, telephone number and

the name of the party who the attorney represents. The filing attorney shall indicate a signature on each signature line by inserting the attorney's typed name or a scanned signature on each applicable line. Bankruptcy Rule 9011 applies to all documents filed.

- D. The following procedure applies when a stipulation or other document requires two or more signatures:
2. The filing attorney shall then file the document electronically, indicating the signatures, by inserting the typed name of all appropriate persons.
